EMCOR PARTNERSHIP WITH NATS STRENGTHENED WITH NEW CONTRACT WIN

EMCOR Engineering Services (EES) has been awarded a £5m contract by NATS to install the operational power systems in its new Air Traffic Control Centre near Prestwick Airport.

EMCOR already has a strong partnership with NATS, the UK's leading provider of air traffic management, with its Facilities Services division (EFS) having been contracted to the company as its principal M&E maintenance provider for over three years. The new contract win is the second EES has won with NATS. This, alongside the continued work of EFS across the company's key operational sites, signals the fruition of EMCOR's ongoing five year strategic plan to develop its capability – through greater integration and transferable skills across its business.

The new Prestwick Air Traffic Control Centre project, which will see EMCOR Engineering Services act a principal Contractor, is at the heart of NATS' strategy to consolidate its operations at two centres at Prestwick and at Swanwick in Hampshire.

When work starts at Prestwick in April, the EES team will be responsible for the full electrical fit out of the equipment and operation rooms in the state-of-the-art flight control facility. This includes the installation of all power distribution, interfacing and transfer equipment, cabling, containment and data.

“The nature of this contract demands the highest possible grade of material, service and maintainability to ensure one hundred percent reliability. EMCOR's existing contract with NATS has proved our shared commitment to delivering this level of quality. This win represents a
