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EMCOR achieves Highly Commended industry accolade and six Golds at RoSPA Health and Safety Awards

EMCOR was Highly Commended for the Engineering Construction sector and awarded six Gold awards at the 2007 RoSPA (Royal Society for the Prevention of Accidents) Occupational Health and Safety Awards.

The awards, which recognise best practice in occupational health and safety management, saw Gold Medal Awards across all three of EMCOR's business units – EMCOR Facilities Services, EMCOR Infrastructure & Rail Services and EMCOR Engineering Services.

EMCOR's industry commendation, awarded to Engineering Services, recognises the company's outstanding performance in health and safety through the implementation of a range of innovative in-house initiatives which has seen the company achieve a 25% year on year reduction in the all injuries Accident Frequency Rates.

Commenting on the awards, Tony Whale, Chief Executive of EMCOR Group, said: "We are extremely proud of our excellent health and safety track record and are delighted that our success continues to be recognised by RoSPA – this is the twelfth consecutive year that EMCOR has won RoSPA awards."

"Our target is zero accidents and the only way to achieve this is to continue to drive and deliver innovative programmes and focus on the continued implementation of consistent best practice. We believe this is not just about providing the highest levels of training which encourages staff to take personal responsibility for their actions, but also the practical adoption of systems at site level - you have to give staff the right tools to be able to do the job properly."

EMCOR's Health and Safety Management system is one of the company's four core competencies across the group and is a major element to its customer offering.

Primary amongst the many elements that have helped drive and deliver sustained performance in this area is a strong Health and Safety culture lead by robust senior management commitment and leadership; performance target setting; employee involvement and proactive safe place and safe person strategies.

A specific initiative that has contributed to EMCOR's award success includes behavioural safety training which builds on the Company's Zero Accident Process (ZAP) by raising awareness to health and safety through personal behaviour. The training is supported by a comprehensive suite of leading edge risk based occupational health protocols that pro-actively address methods of prevention.

EMCOR also operates a 'Take 5' action plan, which encourages employees to take five minutes before starting a job to assess any potential risks and ensure that they have the necessary tools and materials to carry it out effectively and safely.

EMCOR's commitment to Health and Safety is further demonstrated through its reward and recognition programme which grants a monthly £250 safety award to an employee selected from the company's inspection audit and monitoring schemes. A £100 spot prize is also awarded to an individual each month to reward those who proactively demonstrate the company's commitment to Health & Safety.
