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EMCOR GROUP UK Statement: GMB Union Dispute at Heathrow and Gatwick

GMB union members working on the EMCOR UK facilities services contract at Heathrow and Gatwick have opted to take part in a 24 hour stoppage on Friday 7 September 2007 in a dispute over a wage claim. This will not affect service delivery of EMCOR UK's contract at the airports, EMCOR UK has informed ACAS that it would welcome dialogue with all the unions concerned.

The average wage increase of three per cent has already been paid and accepted by 2,500 staff employed by EMCOR Facilities Services in the UK. Of the 320 EMCOR UK employees at Heathrow and Gatwick 230 have agreed to the deal.

EMCOR UK's contract is for the maintenance of buildings, offices, hangars and lounges. EMCOR's staff do not have business critical involvement with flight operations; service delivery relates specifically to the comfort of passengers in the lounges, offices, hangars and other places of work.

EMCOR UK has enjoyed an excellent 14 year continuous working partnership at Heathrow and its contract extension provides job continuity for all staff.
